If the group is to continue (from September) we need a volunteer to take on the role of co-ordinator. One suggestion has been put to me is to meet in the Deer's Leap where orders can be placed from the menu on the night rather than having to pre-order. This would then just require a volunteer to give a number to the venue a day or two in advance so they can reserve a table, rather than having to submit details of meal choices in advance. This would make it, hopefully, a much easier and less stressful task!! But this decision to change venue would be down to the members! If anyone would be prepared to take on the co-ordinator role please let me know as soon as you can as it would be a real pity if the group could not continue.
