The bus will leave Morriston at 9 a.m. and then leave Tenby to return at 4.30 p.m. There is a service in St. Mary's, Tenby for those wishing to attend at 12 midday.

Possible Trip To Bruges : we are hoping to organise a 5 day (4 night) trip to Bruges in October . The cost (if we get 45 people) is £399 per head (there will be a single room supplement if required). Can you please add your name to the list at the back of church very soon if you would be interested, so we know if this is worth pursuing. There are two possible dates either 16th October or 30th October (which is half term) - please indicate which of these dates would be best or if you don't have a preference. Please note you will need a current passport and will need to arrange travel insurance.
