Annual Report: The Annual report and finances was sent out with the weekly email. For those who requested printed copies they are available today. Our Annual Parish meeting will take place on Sunday 16th April following the morning service. Please note that this year there are no elections for a PCC as there will no longer be a PCC for the Parish (as the Parish will cease to exist once we become a Ministry Area). . A Ministry Area Council is to be formed that will be the Governing Body once the new Ministry Area is inaugurated. We are allowed to appoint sub-wardens for the church. Nomination forms are at the back of church. Nominations forms are also available for those who wish to service as the Ministry Area Wardens (these nominations are open to anyone from across the Ministry Area) . There are also nomination forms to elect 'one' representative from this church to serve on the new Ministry Area Council (trustee of the Ministry Area) - if you would like to do this please complete the form prior to our AVM - job descriptions for the Ministry Area Wardens and the Ministry Area Council Representatives are available on the Diocesan Website. The Diocese is appointing paid administrators for each of the New Ministry Areas. If you would like to apply the job description and application form is on the Diocesan Website.

Crypt Cleaning: with the Crypt now being used by so many groups, which is wonderful to see, we need to put in place additional help to ensure the crypt is clean and tidy for all users. If you can volunteer to help on a rota with this can you please let Margaret Jones know.

Flower Rota: there is now a new flower rota in the church porch if you wish to sponsor the altar flowers on a particular Sunday. The list will begin following Easter.
